SUBJECT: Service Station Brushing Lacquers

Service Station Brushing Lacquers for large gasoline producers and distributors were specially formulated to resist the effects of gasoline and oil. Since their biggest sales will be for finishing service station gasoline pumps, they can also be used to excellent advantage in the general maintenance of service stations and their equipment for the finishing and renewing of compressors, piping, tanks, valves, as well as for floors, walls, and woodwork.

Service Station Brushing Lacquers are applied similar to our other brushing lacquers and have the same advantages of quick drying, durability, and beauty of finish. They can be used on metal or wood and over old or new surfaces. They are of full body, ready for use as they come in the package, which permits brushing sufficiently to allow the finish to go on easily and smoothly without laps.

Full directions for their use will be found on the Service Station Brushing Lacquer color card, Form CC-259, which also serves to illustrate and describe the range of all practical colors plus aluminum, black, white, and clear. These bright, vivid colors represent exact color matches of the pump enamel standards of all the leading petroleum producers. Where desired, innumerable shades and tints can be produced by intermixing.

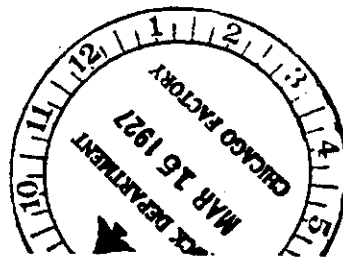
