

1 stamp or label on the box; is that correct, sir?

2 A Well, as far as I know, that is 1957.

3 Owens-Corning was just delivering or selling it at
4 that point. They weren't manufacturing it.

5 Q I am sorry, I meant to use just the word
6 distributing.

7 So the Kaylo that they would have
8 distributed to the Cathedral of Mary, Our Queen would
9 not have had any type of stamp or label on it; is that
10 correct, sir?

11 A As far as I know, yes.

12 Q And you don't have any evidence from Owens-
13 Corning here today to indicate that Wallace & Gale was
14 not a licensed or permitted company to put Kaylo on
15 insulation and pipe during that period of time at the
16 Cathedral of Mary, Our Queen; you don't have any
17 information here today?

18 A No, I don't.

19 Q I would take it in 1958, when Owens-Corning
20 not only distributed Kaylo, but also manufactured it
21 in '58, that since it is before '66, at Sinai Hospital
