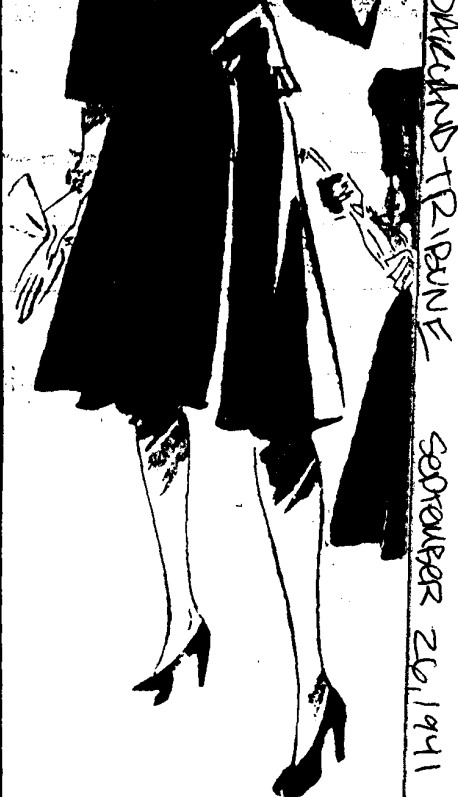

"MADE IT CLEAR"
 Under the circumstances, the President said, he felt that it would be useless to insist upon the repeal legislation—declared that they made it clear to them at the conference that the opponents would have to take the sole responsibility for the results of their opposition.

The approach of war was visible to him as early as 1937, the President reiterated, when he made a speech in Chicago calling for a quarantine of international aggressors "in order to protect the health of the community against the spread of the disease."

His repeated warnings to the Nation and Congress were largely ignored, Roosevelt said, because "there were, unfortunately, many Americans as there were many citizens in other democratic Nations throughout the world, who refused to believe that war was probable, or even that it was possible."

In the last two years, however, the President said, he detected a rising belief among the American people that "although they did not want to become a part of the war, the war was, nevertheless, very strictly and emphatically becoming more and more a part of their business and concern."

U.S.C. Head Warns Against Isolation

LOS ANGELES, Sept. 26.—(AP)—Dr. Rufus B. von Klein Smid, president of the University of Southern California, addressed the university's first assembly of the term yesterday with a warning against isolationism.

"Cyclone-cellar citizens had better learn—if they think they can close the door over their heads for protection and not be awake to the lessons of history now going on about them—that their attitude is perpetuating a fallacy which will in time mean the utter destruction of our Government," Dr. von Klein Smid said.

"Although war should be the most abhorred and contemptible human experience, still we have not grown in grace and virtue sufficiently fast, or in common sense enough to make war impossible."

Dr. von Klein Smid said there was "still a way out of war, and that is to gather around a conference table, leaving our guns at home."

Everlasting Potato Chip Produced by Government Experts

CHICAGO, Sept. 26.—(AP)—A non-perishable potato chip is the Government's latest contribution to the march of mankind.

The Bureau of Dairy Industry announced today its experiments have produced a crisp wafer, resembling a potato chip, which contains no fat and is therefore resistant to decay.

In order to make the wafer, the bureau said, you combine concentrated skim milk with boiled potatoes. You incorporate air by whipping. Then the mixture is "extruded through corrugated openings in the form of a ribbon and is dried in a tunnel drier," as the bureau succinctly puts it.

The bureau guarantees the result: an everlasting potato chip will keep indefinitely, if you want it.

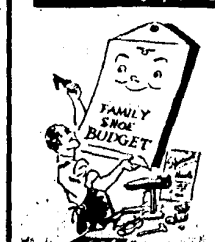
