Dear Sir:

At the request of Mr. R. L. Jordan, Division Manager of the Chicago Office of the Ethyl Gasoline Corporation, I am handing you enclosed a typewritten copy of the hospital record of the Illinois Research and Educational Hospital, concerning the illness of one [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] is the plaintiff in a suit against the Packard Motor Car Company of Chicago in the Superior Court of Cook County, for a sickness claimed to be lead poisoning due to inhaling ethyl gasoline fumes leaking from some part of a heater or exhaust from a used Packard automobile which he had purchased from the Packard Motor Car Company, in which he used ethyl gasoline, which he alleges was recommended by the agents and servants of the Packard Motor Car Company. [REDACTED] business at the time of the purchase of the car was, and he is, an embalmer.

Mr. Jordan advises me that you would like to analyze the hospital record, and I shall be pleased to have a report of your findings, together with any technical data that you may be able to give me as to whether or not an individual who drives an automobile, in which he uses ethyl gasoline, can suffer as a consequence lead poisoning by inhalation of exhaust fumes that might leak from the exhaust or from a leaky gasoline line. Please return the hospital record when it has served your purpose.

I am sending a copy of this letter to Mr. Jordan for his information.
