Dear all,

We have received a second inquiry for a meeting from the American Chamber of Commerce, AmCham. Although the subject is said to be F-gases, I think this could be relevant for the whole group as this group represents a major industry.

My first thought is that we may well have a meeting, but what is the best timing? Our regulatory approach is currently under development, and we do not want to discuss this with industry. We also have the 2nd stakeholder consultation ongoing, and therefore we have not yet finalized our compilation of information and our assessment of the F-gases (and other applications). Hence, it would perhaps be more convenient for us to postpone a meeting until we have compiled the information from the consultation.

Any thoughts on this? I am not sure what we could expect from this group. Maybe more politics than data.
