Kirk,

Could you extend an invitation on my behalf to Ryan Jackson of EPA? As I think I mentioned to you before, I knew Ryan on the Hill, but it's been a few years. I also don't have his EPA contact info.

We hope Ryan would agree to attend a one-hour meeting of the Energy & Environment Coordinating Committee here at Business Roundtable. The Committee is made up of representatives of BRT member companies who are interested in energy and environment policy issues. I'd guess thirty or so individuals would likely attend.

Our hope is that Ryan could speak for 10-15 minutes about how he sees the Administration's priorities shaping up at EPA, and then have a robust discussion. He should be aware that we recently filed comment on New Source Review and Clean Air operating permits. We also have a long-standing interest in ozone regulation.
