6. Saflex Unit, including without limitation, Saflex plastic interlayer product, Butvar polyvinyl butyral resin and ethyl acetate.
7. Phosphorus and Derivatives Unit, including without limitation, phosphoric acid, food grade and technical; fire control chemicals; phosphates, including without limitation, orthophosphates, polyphosphates, calcium, potassium, sodium and ammonium phosphates, food phosphates and phosphate salts; and merchant market sales of phosphorus, phosphorus trichloride and P_2S_5 .

Resins Unit, including without limitation, styrene maleic anhydride resins, crosslinkers, pressure sensitive adhesives, flow modifiers, acrylic solvent, acrylic emulsion, polyvinyl butyral, specialty solvents; and plastic products, including without limitation, doormats, spray control systems, drainage systems and poultry nests.
9. Polymer Modifiers Unit including without limitation plasticizers, benzyl phthalates, adipate esters, polymer modifiers, polymer modifier production co-products, polymer additives and Santotac.
