3 MR. LELIEVRE: 1:18 p.m., we are now back on
4 the record. Please commence.

5 BY MR. PURCELL:

6 Q Good afternoon, Mr. Drislane. You still
7 appreciate, do you not, that even though we had a lunch break
8 you are still under oath and the same rules and regulations,
9 if you will, that applied to our proceeding this morning
10 still apply this afternoon. You appreciate that, don't you?

11 A Yes.

12 Q Okay. Mr. Drislane, I would like to ask you about
13 the size of the FMSI itself, not including the members. I'm
14 interested in people such as yourself that worked for the
15 FMSI. On a couple of occasions you have mentioned it was a

18 the FMSI going through including the period where you were
19 executive director?
