Confirming my conversation with you on 2/26/68, U. S. Steel Corporation, Fairless Works, is placing an order with us for 50 sets of the 29 x 66 two piece. This will be a "B" revision and the HT-6 Revision is attached. This material as covered in the revision should be made of EP-3408 and should include, instead of the original hardware design, the heavy duty spring clips figure-seven-type as last shipped for the 29 x 56. Per copy of this memorandum to Geof Fenton, please duplicate the 50 sets of 50 spring clips and ship by Emery Air Freight on this design so that we can standardize on spring clips for the various molds. Also Geof should note the design on the 27 x 45 mold and determine if this same spring clip can be used here.

We will remain on this design with the FA-302 hangers for flush setting. Although for protection change the design slightly, Geof, so that these FA-302 hangers are actually an inch to one-half inch down due to mold top variation and cleanliness.

As per my conversation with you today, please place a priority on getting these through as we anticipate additional testing of this mold design and 3406 PROFAX on March 8th, and this only gives us two weeks to ship this material in. As soon as you advise me what the exact packaging amount will be closest to 50 sets, I will have an order number for you.

Please advise me as soon as possible when these can be shipped.
