Samples were obtained on November 14, 1974 by Gollob Analytical Service personnel. Sample # 1 was collected on a charcoal absorption tube, while evacuated glass bulbs were used for A and B.

It was also observed that the vinyl stock was considerably more than during the last sampling of October 31, 1974.
