Dear Doctor:

You will be interested to know that this morning we received advice from the State Industrial Commission of Oklahoma holding against the claimant in the case of [REDACTED] vs. Skelly Oil Company. That is the case where there was some contention as to lead poisoning from handling Ethyl gasoline. The Commission held that claimant had not proved the happening of an accident and that is a necessary prerequisite under the workmen's compensation law of this state. Claimant's attorney is threatening to file a common law action in the courts based upon the proposition of an unsafe place to work. We are not alarmed about that but will meet such an issue if and when it is presented.

You were kind enough to loan me the transcript of the testimony in the case where you had previously testified in California. I am now returning this to you under separate cover and wish to again thank you for your helpfulness in making this available to us for our examination.
