"LUCITE" PAINTS - HUMAN PATCH TESTS

Copies of the report of the skin tests carried out with various wall paints by Albert M. Kligman, M.D., Professor of Dermatology at the School of Medicine, University of Pennsylvania, are attached.

The products tested were coded as follows:

Since there was no evidence of primary irritation or sensitization in any of the 200 subjects, this information should provide valuable data in answering dermatitis complaints with respect to these paints.
