The data in the attached report from Younger Laboratories indicates that the fluorination of the Aroclor 1254 increases the toxicity of the Aroclor particularly as regards the skin absorption lethal dose in rabbits. A lethal dose between 158 and 251 mg/kg brackets the 200 mg. figure. Compounds with a skin LD₅₀ of 200 or less mg. has to be classified as a "Class B Poison" and a label has to carry the word "POISON" in large letters and a skull and cross bones.
