Dear Mr. Howard:

It was recently noticed that on shipments of Nylal 300, our code 62-32-00 that there was no type of caution label on these bags. It is our understanding, according to various OSHA regulations that there is specific types of labeling required on products such as the Nylal.

We, therefore, request that R. T. Vanderbilt comply with our purchase order instructions which state, "ALL HAZARDOUS MATERIALS must be labeled with a warning statement, indicating the material or ingredient by name and the hazard involved", and also any Federal regulation in regard to labeling. We interpret these regulations to mean products such as various Talos purchased from R. T. Vanderbilt.

May we please have your confirmation on this matter.
