DIRECTIONS

The surface to be covered should first be thoroughly cleaned by means of a stiff brush or broom. The paste should then be applied by using a trowel, putty knife or other similar tool.

Should it be necessary to seal a large opening, a sheet of roofing paper, canvas or sheet metal of proper size should be cut on the under side and then nailed in place. The upper side should then also be coated with this Plastic Cement.

Keep container closed when not in use. If this is done, the contents will keep permanently.
