Dear Mr. Mittnacht:

I am sending you herewith three copies of a memorandum which I have prepared on the results of my European survey containing certain recommendations. Not having heard from Mr. Webb and not being sure that he is in his office, I am sending these to you. I would suggest that the original copy go to Mr. Webb and that such disposition be made of the others as seem advisable to you. In the course of the next few days, I shall extend this memorandum to include the results of Dr. Machlo's trip to South America. However, you may rest assured that our specific recommendations for South America will comply with the general principles of the program which I have outlined.

I have already indicated to you that I consider it imperative that we extend our information and that we apply this policy to the activity of the Corporation in Mexico, in the Australian territory, and in the far East in general. Lacking detailed information, we shall not be able to make specific recommendations concerning these latter areas, but I feel that it is very important indeed that these matters should be straightened out with all possible dispatch. I think it will be necessary as soon as we can get clearly in mind the details of the matter in South America, for me to come along to New York and discuss with Mr. Webb and yourself the best means of getting a proper safety program in operation in all fields of the Corporation's activities.
