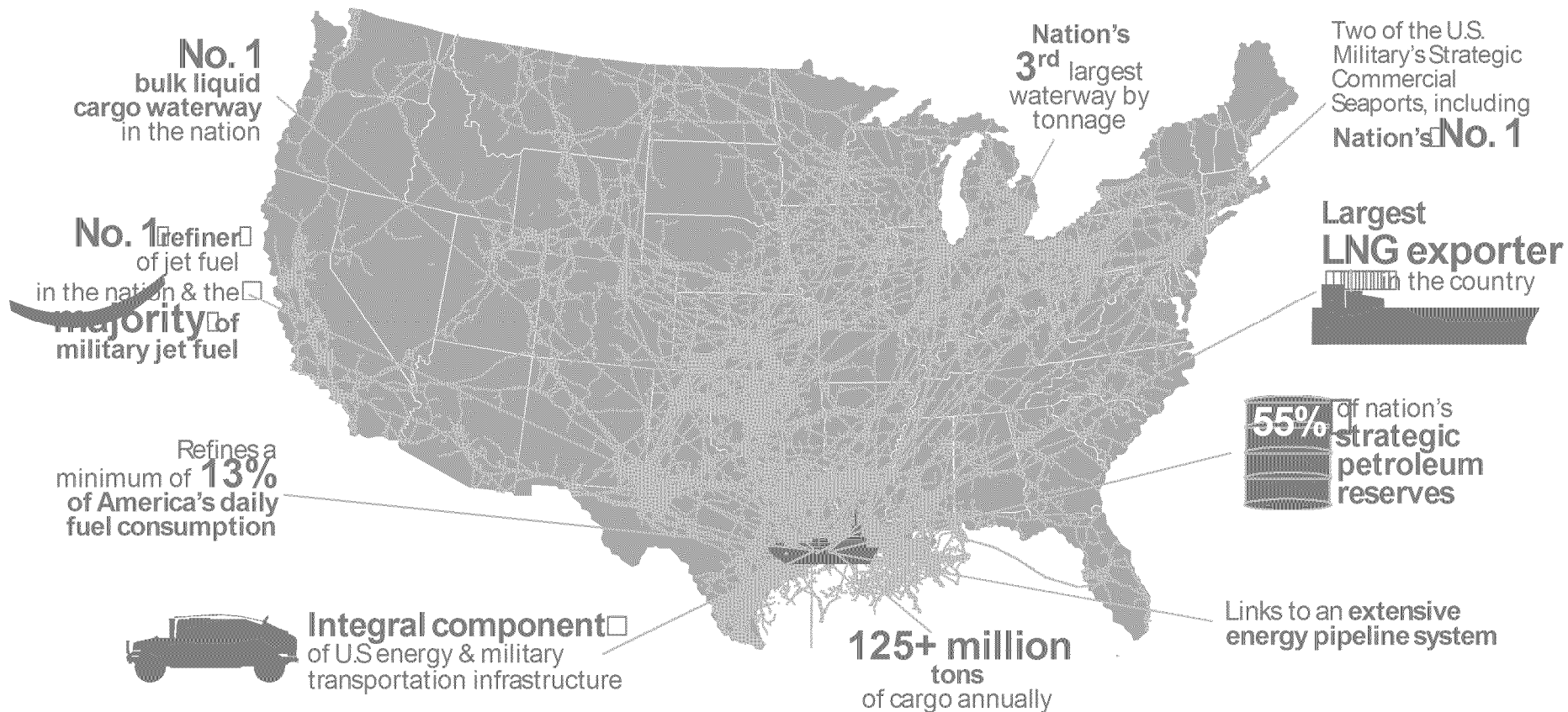
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THE SABINE-NECHES WATERWAY: AN IMPROVEMENT PROJECT OF NATIONAL SIGNIFICANCE

The Sabine-Neches Waterway is America's energy gateway. It is home to numerous manufacturing, refining and petrochemical companies and links to an extensive energy pipeline system, which connects to nearly every state in the country. The waterway is vital for America's military deployment and critical to the nation's security domestically and abroad.

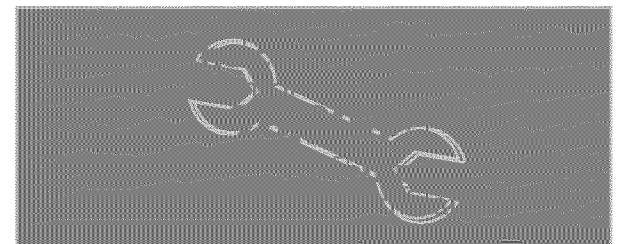
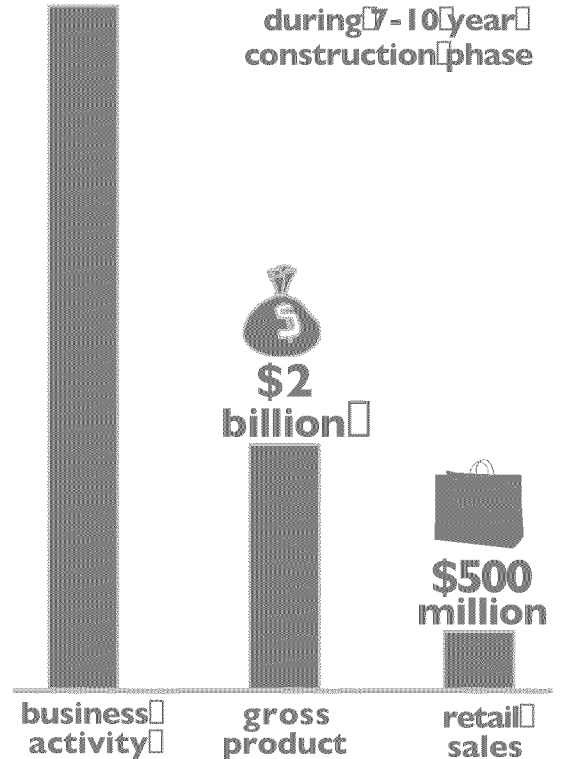
