

1 MR. WILLIAMS: That is correct, Your Honor.

2 THE COURT: Hearing no objection.

3 MR. WILLIAMS: That is correct, Your Honor,
4 no objection.

5 MS. HINES: Also moving in Wood 14 which are
6 the funeral bills, Wood 15, which is the letter of
7 administration appointing Mrs. Rosanna Wood as
8 personal representative of the estate.

9 Wood Miscellaneous 03 is the same as the
10 Grewe life expectancy table, and we would adopt all
11 evidence and testimony in the Grewe case in the Wood
12 case.

13 THE COURT: Very well.

14 (Whereupon, Plaintiff's Wood Exhibit Numbers
15 01 through 07, 09, 11, 13, 14, 15, Miscellaneous 03
16 were received into evidence.)

17 MR. SHELLENBERGER: One final request, Your
