3 Q Other than Mr. McGovern of Raybestos-Manhattan,
4 Mr. Moalli of Raybestos-Manhattan and Mr. Nelson of Abex, do
5 you recall any other gentlemen who because of their lengthy
6 service at the FMSI were in some fashion honored in a special
7 way by the FMSI?

8 A We honored our legal counsel.

9 Q Mr. Stickles?

10 A Who was gouging us of the best firing we ever
11 made.

12 Q That's Mr. Stickles?

13 A Yes.

14 Q Okay. Other than Mr. Stickles as your legal
15 counsel, I'm interested mainly in members of the Institute
16 whether any others other than those three gentleman from
17 Raybestos-Manhattan and Abex that were some way honored
18 because of their service at the Institute?

19 A I don't believe so.

20 Q On page 21, then, we turn to the presidency of Mr.
21 Simon and you indicate in this portion of your history that
22 in December of 1975 the FMSI with the Asbestos Study
23 Committee chairman who then is Mr. Wagner of Carlisle --
