His services are necessary to determine exactly what further engineering studies are necessary and in what areas and as to which hazards.

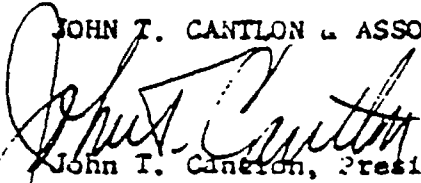
Dr. Mancuso, of course, has been working with your Personnel and Medical Departments and has inspected most of the plant and feels that at this point, these additional professional services are needed.
