In purchasing the raw materials for the new product, please change the minimums of the basic material to a minimum truckload of Dentonite clay (16 tons) and a minimum carload of asbestos fiber which may be 30 tons in most plants and possibly 40 tons at Sigurd.

In discussing the way Mr. Watt's memorandum had been worded to the Plant Managers on this subject under date of April 22 with Mr. Diefenbach, he agreed that there was a misinterpretation of the limitations that had been set on stocking this and that the approval had been given on the basis of stocking 1/2 month's supply to make the material which roughly meant 500 tons of finished products - a total figure for the five plants.
