Dear Mr. Couchman:-

As promised over the phone yesterday, I am enclosing three copies of the bulletin sent to our members yesterday. We would appreciate official copies of the ordinance when you distribute them.

Our industry has always recommended precautionary labeling. The wording required in the Baltimore ordinance differs from that in New York City, Kansas and Illinois. Therefore it is a definite hardship to manufacturers in Baltimore who distribute in other States and to other manufacturers who sell in Baltimore. It is our strong desire that, when the regulations are issued, the warning statement will be changed to conform to New York City.

I assure you that our industry will cooperate fully in an educational program to reduce accident due to the misuse of our products.

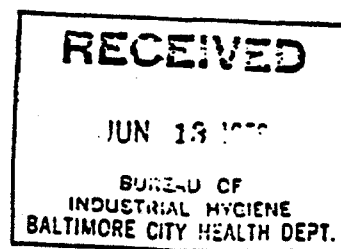
