Dr. Howland and I have just been over Dr. Aub's manuscript on Lead Poisoning submitted for Medicine. The printers estimated three hundred printed pages will be required for publication. They are willing to publish this in total but in view of the fact that there is a great deal of original matter presented in detail Dr. Howland and I thought best to inquire whether you thought it advisable to ask Dr. Aub to take certain extracts from his monograph to constitute his article for Medicine and have the entire manuscript published as a monograph by William and Wilkins.
