Subject: EXPOSURE of BRAKE MECHANICS to ASBESTOS FIBERS

References: Industrial Hygiene Bulletins 4, 4a, 4c

A new EPA videotape on controlling brake mechanics' exposures to asbestos dust and airborne fibers is available. "Don't Blow It!" covers the potential health hazards from exposure to asbestos in brake dust and how to effectively control brake dust. The 15-minute tape is designed for use by brake and fleet garage mechanics and vocational schools. Auto and truck dealer mechanics, tow tractor and plant lift truck mechanics, and fleet truck and locomotive brake mechanics will find the program useful. We recommend this videotape for asbestos hazard communication training programs for brake mechanics.

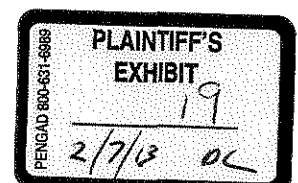
