

1 to what we actually did to the patient when he was in
2 the hospital.

3 It says the patient was admitted in the
4 hospital, was treated with parenteral analgesics. And
5 parenteral means injection. And the reason for that
6 was because the oral pain medications weren't
7 working.

8 He required three to four injections of
9 morphine daily for the first four days in the
10 hospital, but on the fifth day was able to be
11 controlled only with MS Contin and oral morphine.

12 Q Thank you. Doctor, I am going to show you
13 one other discharge summary from March of 1990.

14 This is the one preceding this one.

15 A It says reason for admission, pain control
16 and dyspnea, which means shortness of breath, and the
17 procedure in the hospital was a pain control
18 procedure.

19 And then a CAT scan was performed, at which
20 time a needle was inserted into the right side of his
21 chest to remove fluid in an attempt to alleviate some
