The Oct 3 meeting is closed press. If this works out, I will also then follow up with information for any security detail.

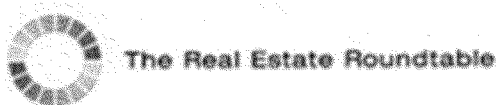
