There was one mad rush to close in about the car and win a coveted handshake from the champion of protection, and many were those who grasped his hand. The cheering, the applause and the confusion was so great that it was next to impossible for the President to make himself heard, but he had started as follows: "Fellow-citizens: Of all the people I have seen since I arrived in California this—" but the train had already started and the rest of the sentence was lost on the breeze, the cheering of the crowd continuing while the train sped away, the President bowing from the rear car platform till far down the track.
