2 by the bronchi and then swept out of the lungs.

3 Q Now, I asked you earlier or started off with
4 a question about what is diffuse malignant
5 mesothelioma, and does this slide depict in any
6 fashion a malignant mesothelioma?

7 A No, sir. I think that is on the next
8 slide. Mesothelioma is a cancer of this thin lining,
9 the mesothelial lining of the lungs, and I think that
10 that is on the next slide.

11 MR. IGNATOWSKI: I would like to now refer
12 the Doctor to what has been previously marked as
13 Gabrielson Slide Number 2 for identification only.

14 (Whereupon, Plaintiff's Gabrielson Exhibit
15 Number 2 was marked for identification.)

16 BY MR. IGNATOWSKI:

17 Q Could you tell us, Dr. Gabrielson, what this
18 slide is and where it is from?

19 A It is a slide, again, Dr. Netter prepared
20 and, again, it would be a drawing that depicts an
21 opened chest with the front of the chest removed.
