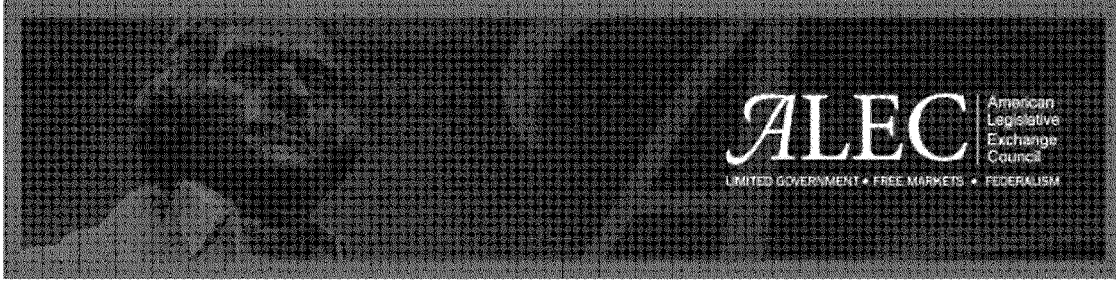


# American Legislative Exchange Council

- ALEC was founded in 1973
- 2018 will be the 45<sup>th</sup> anniversary for ALEC
- ALEC has four Centers of Excellence that conduct research and inform policy innovation. The Center to Restore the Balance of Government, the Center for State Fiscal Reform, the Center to Protect Free Speech and the Center for Innovation and Technology.
- ALEC has nine task forces covering a variety of economic issues of importance to the American people, including job creation and growth, state tax issues and budget solvency, education and healthcare reforms, corrections and reentry programs, civil justice reforms and sound energy and environmental solutions.
