OSHA GUIDELINES FOR REPEATED VIOLATIONS

Mr. Armstrong, Chairman of our Health and Environmental Affairs Committee, has suggested that the enclosed guidelines for handling repeated OSHA Violations be distributed to the Membership.

Two points in the guidelines are summarized as follows:

1. To be cited as a repeated violation, the violation must occur at the "same establishment" within three years of the date the original violation became a final order, or within three years of the correction date, whichever is later.
2. A multi-facility employer would not be cited if the violation recurred at a plant or business other than the one originally cited.
