SECTION 1. That Section 31 of Ordinance No. 528 C.S. of the City of Monterey entitled "Monterey Zoning Ordinance" duly adopted on the 24th day of September, 1940 be amended to read as follows:
SECTION 31. The several districts, and each thereof together with their boundaries are hereby established as shown on that certain map entitled "Index to Sectional District Maps" and designated as Section 4.1 hereof and by those certain maps entitled Sectional District Maps Showing the Zoning Plan" and designated Section 4.2, 4.21, 4.22 and 4.24 hereof. All notations, references and other information shown on said maps are as much a part of this Ordinance as if the matters and information set forth by said maps were fully described in the text of this Ordinance.

SECTION 2. That Section 4 of Ordinance No. 528 C.S. of the City of Monterey entitled "Monterey Zoning Ordinance" duly adopted on the 24th day of September, 1940, be amended to read as follows:
