 Property No. ~~6324-92~~ 6328-352

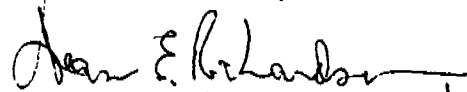
One pc. electric motor for same, Property No. 6213-16673.
