TARGET AUDIENCE:

Designed to provide employees the knowledge and skills necessary to safely deal with asbestos hazards on the job. This course is for employees assigned to specific jobs which involve handling non-friable asbestos-containing materials (brake shoe replacement, floor tile removal, etc.)

PROGRAM OBJECTIVES:

- Recognize hazards related with asbestos exposure.
- Know the health effects of dealing with asbestos.
- Be aware of employee responsibilities.
- Recognition of labels and markings.

PROGRAM CONTENT:

- Physical characteristics of asbestos.
- Routes of possible exposure.
- Industry standard work practices.
- Respiratory and medical surveillance programs.
- Review of regulations.
