Dear Bob,

I enclose herewith final copies of the manuscript reports on the mortality and radiological studies which I have just submitted to the British Journal of Industrial Medicine for publication. It usually takes a month or two to get a reply from them.

As discussed with you during my visit to Cambridge earlier this month, I think it right that I should now make some charge on W.R. Grace & Co. for consultant services which are over and above those associated with the research contract just completed. I enclose a statement describing my time and expenses in connection with the visits to Morgantown, Libby and Cambridge. You will see that I have only allocated two days to the Libby visit and make no reference to the presence of Alison. Since you have always been very kind and generous to us and we were under an obligation to present our results to the employees, I hope you will agree that this seems a fair compromise.

The next two weeks before departure for Cambridge, and my other meetings in September, are going to be very full. As soon as I return at the end of next month, I will contact you again to find out what further information you have managed to obtain about the feasibility and need for further studies in your South Carolina mine and in the expansion plans.
