Members:

The combined operations of auditing and attempting to salvage meaningful data from the vinyl chloride study conducted at Industrial BIO-TEST Laboratories (IBT) are resulting in rapid exhaustion of funds allocated to administrative costs incident to the operations of the Technical Panel on Vinyl Chloride Research.

In view of the foregoing, and pending a definitive course of future action, we proposed to CMA's General Counsel that funds being held in reserve, pending receipt of an acceptable final IBT research report, be transferred to an operating fund which will be needed within the next several weeks to defray administrative costs. General Counsel has approved the proposal.

We shall proceed with transfer of the funds described above unless a majority of Panel members express objections in writing to this office prior to July 16, 1979.
