HOW EAGLE HOME INSULATION IS APPLIED

—AND BY WHOM



This remarkable insulation is *blown* into your walls and into either the attic floor or roof. Light, soft and fluffy, it is blown into place by compressed air. The truck stands in your driveway. The hose stretches from the truck to a small opening in the house wall. An experienced operator holds the nozzle of the hose and directs the flow of Eagle Insulation down through the opening into the empty space between the studding in the wall, and between the joists in the attic. There is no fuss, no muss, no bother. The operators are trained in the best method of removing a single piece of siding, a brick here and there, or making small openings in the stucco up under the eaves, in order to gain access to the spaces between the studding. When they have blown Eagle Insulation into the entire wall, they replace the siding or bricks, or seal the opening in the stucco work. In the attic, the hose is laid in through an attic window so that the men need never intrude on the floors below. The men who do the quick, easy job of insulating your home are trained members of the local Eagle Home Insulating organization, a group which has been selected with the utmost care with respect to financial stability, reputation, careful workmanship and ability to serve the community.
