The references to gasoline additives towards the bottom of the third column of my enclosure may be of some interest to you.

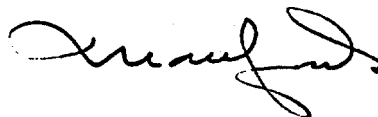
I have just received, more or less in confidence, copies of the following four documents:
