Some time ago, when you were first assuming Pete Maier's responsibility and he had decided to go back to school, as a matter of fact it was the week he was turning over his accounts to you, that you were notified that Bloomfield Silo Company, Bloomfield, Indiana was having trouble with some of their silo paints.

As you know, Bloomfield Silo Company requested you help on some silo's they had painted in the state of Ohio using your old Aroclor 5460 and Aroclor 1221. As the story goes, Bloomfield Silo tells me there are two large dairy farmers over there that claim their paint because of the Aroclor's caused contamination and they had to throw out several hundred of gallons of milk because of the alleged contamination. Mr. Rex Autry of Bloomfield Silo indicated that it is his thought there will be a forthcoming law suit over this matter and he said that he thought sure Monsanto would be notified of this suit.

I am wondering if you have received any formal notice of this problem other than from Hoosier Solvents and if so what the status of this case might be.

Can you give us an indication on how this problem is working out.
