Dear Sir,

PLANT. Referring to arrangement plan No. B.M.D.
5014, it has now been decided not to instal the trommels and the
return elevators shown following the gyratory crusher and the
vertical hammer mill. The position of other equipment should
remain as shown on this plan, however, as we may wish to instal
the two trommels at a later date.

In the meantime, you should construct a chute (which
need be only timber lined with sheet metal) to carry the materia
from the crusher or hammer mill to the respective screen. The
chute from the hammer mill should have a removable cover fitted,
as this machine creates a strong draught, and if no cover is
fitted the dust nuisance will be unbearable. It may be found
necessary when we commence production to run a pipe from our
suction system to this chute to reduce the dust nuisance.
