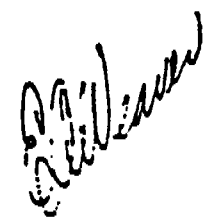
You will find attached termination notices on the three rejected employees mentioned in your letter of January 28, 1955.

We have also terminated all employees which Dr. Cowan has accepted for non-dusty employment only, since I feel that an employee is subject to dust occasionally any place in our particular plant.

I cannot find anywhere in our procedures where it states that you are to receive termination notices on the hourly employees. Do you want these notices on only the employees rejected by Dr. Cowan, or on all employees terminated?

In your letter you asked if P. R. Johnson was considered a temporary employee. The answer to that question is "Yes." Mr. Johnson and several other employees were hired strictly as temporary employees during our construction period. It is possible that Mr. Johnson and a few other Maintenance workers will be retained. As soon as we are sure which men will make our best maintenance workers we will have x-rays made of these men.

As we rely on the information supplied on the termination notice, we would appreciate it if you would follow this procedure in the future.
