couch being discussed.

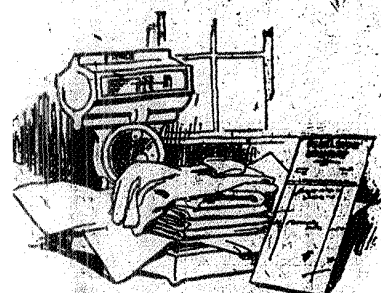
