**GENERAL RELEASE -
EAGLO-PAINT & VARNISH CORPORATION**

In accordance with your request I have prepared and am attaching hereto copies of a proposed release to be executed by Eaglo-Paint & Varnish Corporation in favor of du Pont relative to certain variations in the properties of du Pont's "Ti-Cal" supplied to this firm.

I have also attached hereto a proposed covering letter for submission of this release to Eaglo-Paint & Varnish Corporation. As you can well appreciate, it is pretty standard practice in the Company to require that the release be executed before actual payment is made. Otherwise there is a risk that although payment may be made, the release may never be executed, thereby defeating the protection intended to be afforded du Pont by the release. In view thereof, you should consider the advisability of having some representative of your New York office take this release and check to Mr. Hillman and have him execute it in the presence of your representative, at which time your man could give Mr. Hillman the check for the \$15,000.
