When Miss Duclos, the three men and the explosives were seized here February 18, the accused leader was quoted by police as saying: "I wanted to draw attention to the condition of my face."

The arrests culminated the undercover work of a Negro New York city policeman, Raymond Wood, who infiltrated an extremist organization known as the Black Liberation Front, described as ideologically linked to Red China and Castro Cuba.

Awaiting trial for conspiracy are Robert S. Collier, 28, self-styled leader of the Black Liberation Front; Walter A. Bowe, 32; and Khaleel S. Seyyed, 22.

the time to determine delays have occurred their effect on the schedule.

The major delays

• A nine-month lag opening of the East from Richmond to 1—originally set for 1968.

• A five-month lag the Concord-to-Daly now projected for May.

These delays, said J. Folk, the District man, don't mean that in trouble now.

"But any further it will get us into trouble. I'm confident that the system will still be on at our original target 1971."

Folk said the delays have been caused by various community recommendations, some of them go as well as "lawsuits and of lawsuits."

The door must be, he said, on any recommendations, practical ones and any factors will prevent ever finishing them.

Folk said that "a border-to-border system in Berkeley" cause "an added 15% lay" and "result in the taxpayer of \$25 million inflationary increases."

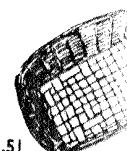

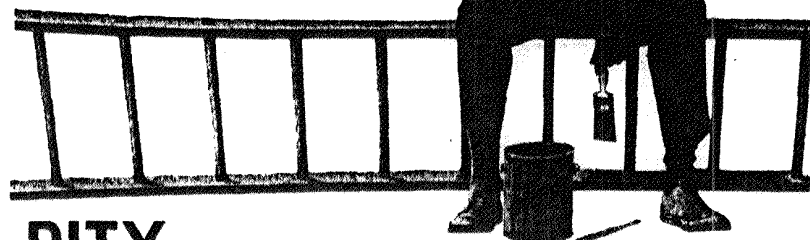
