Item 13208 - FACTORY OPERATIONS

Appeal is to be made for extra oil for industrial business this quarter. Mr. Goldberg to handle after information supplied him from Cleveland.

Item 13210 - RAW MATERIALS

Exempt Oil - Mr. Hennig to check back to April 1st to determine whether any military "end use" business has not been so reported. Messrs. Lemperly and Reese to secure similar information on Stores and Districts, re orders holding.

Resin - Approval given Purchasing Department for 2,000 drums of Grade WG to be purchased on a basis of monthly average price during delivery period, if possible.

Item 13213 - ACETIC ACID CARBOYS

Mr. Reese is to follow Mr. Van Cleve to secure prompt return of these containers.

Item 13214 - PIGMENTS

Messrs. Mills and Coolidge to check on possibility of using pulp lead at Cleveland and Detroit. Also to check possibility of using less double strength Lithopone.

Item 13219 - MILWAUKEE POST-WAR STORE

Mr. Lemperly to submit a report showing cost of a post-war modernization program for our store on the basis of Stores Department's recommendations.

Item 13220 - TERMINATION OF CONTRACTS

Mr. Lemperly to see that Sales executives are properly informed on latest Government rulings.

Item 13223 - KEM-TONE PRODUCTS

Kem-Tone Roller-Coaters - Landon P. Smith, Inc. to be asked to submit a sample of product they can supply us when raw material restrictions are eased.

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
