Gentlemen:

XX Zinc:

We acknowledge receipt of your night message of the 8th inst., and note your instructions to place order with the New Jersey Zinc Co. for one car XX Zinc for shipment not earlier than Dec. 1920. Also note your request for guarantee against decline.

In reply beg to advise that we have placed order with the New Jersey Zinc Co. at price quoted, viz:--
10 $\frac{1}{2}$ ¢ per lb. Feb Hazard, Pa. less usual freight allowance of 50¢ per 100 lbs., and will have shipment made as requested.

Regarding guarantee, the New Jersey Co. say they do not give any written guarantees against decline in price, but assure us that if there should be a decline they will take care of us. On the other hand, they are sending us a contract for the 20 tons in question so as to protect us against any advance that might take place.
