For the interrogations in the subject litigation, I am attaching three facsimiles of the vinyl resin bags used by UCC during the 1960's and 1970's. Please remember that these are multiwall brown kraft paper bags measuring about 32 inches by 16 inches when filled.

1. Plate BE is a replica of the bag used for suspension and nonsolvent resins. The cancer warning was added in 1975 as required by OSHA.
2. Plate AJ is a replica of the bag used for dispersion resin (QYNY).
3. Plate BG is a replica of the bag used for suspension and nonsolvent resins to be exported.

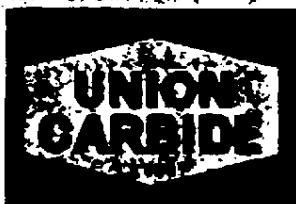
