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DON FOWLER JOINS LEAD INDUSTRIES  
AS INDUSTRIAL HYGIENIST

Don Fowler, former Chief of Industrial Hygiene for the Chrysler Corporation, has joined the Lead Industries Association. Mr. Fowler will succeed the late Manfred Bowditch as the association's Health and Safety Director. In this capacity he will be responsible for the continuing program of Lead Industries Association for gathering data and assisting in the setting of standards and acceptable practices for the industrial and domestic use of lead and lead products. Mr. Fowler is a past president of the Michigan Industrial Hygiene Society and was chairman of the Carbon Monoxide Sub Group of the Automobile Manufacturers' Association.
