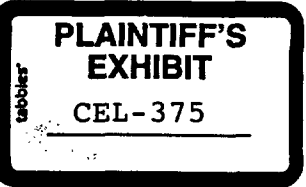

SAFETY LETTER # 1

SUBJECT: Asbestos Handling Personnel

The following Arthur Brothers employee's have received a comprehensive medical examination as required by OSHA for exposure to airborne asbestos fiber:

They have received instructions on the proper method and equipment necessary for handling and disposing of asbestos material. Medical records should be maintained on these employee's for a minimum of twenty years. Records of exposure levels monitored must be maintained for at least three years and shall be made available upon request to the Assistant Secretary of Labor for Occupational Safety and Health, the Director of the National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health, and to authorized representatives of either.

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ASBESTOS HANDLING PERSONNEL (Con't)

Should any of these employee's be terminated, they will be offered a medical examination within 30 calendar days after termination. No examination is required if adequate records show that the employee has been examined within the past one year period.
