Subject: Vinyl Chloride Research Program - Continuation
of Multi-Component Studies at the University of
Louisville

The Technical Panel on Vinyl Chloride Research recommends continuation of the multi-component research program being conducted by Dr. C. Tamburro at the School of Medicine, University of Louisville. This research has as its objectives the design of methods for early detection, prevention, diagnosis and treatment of those individuals exposed to potentially toxic chemicals with the aim of preventing any serious injury, pre-cancerous lesions, or the development of cancer either on a short or long-term basis. The program is designed to identify, at the earliest possible time, potentially harmful chemicals and to lead to a reduction in their exposure based on objective chemical data. This is the third year of a three-year research program and it is the view of Panel members that if this overall program is to yield optimum results it is important that continuity be preserved.

The technical proposal and budget involve three parts:

A. Research Techniques and Methods for Detection and Prevention of Carcinogenesis in Industrial Workers	\$260,734
B. Whole Body Autoradiographic Study of Vinyl Chloride	\$ 13,500
C. Vinyl Chloride Metabolism in Isolated Mammalian Liver Cells	\$ 13,550
TOTAL	\$287,784

Administration costs will be covered by funds remaining from the second year of research.

The technical proposal, sent to your company's Technical Representative on October 4, 1978, contains additional information on the type of research being conducted and a breakdown of costs.

The attached response form lists your company's maximum pro rata share. Should the number of companies participating be greater than anticipated, your company's share will be reduced proportionately.

Work under the second year of research will be completed in February 1979. In an effort toward eliminating the costly interruption of this research, we request that you return the attached commitment form by December 22.

Dear Mr. Kolcum:

In view of your acquisition of Allied Chemical's vinyl chloride facilities and confirming our telephone conversation of last week, I am sending you information on the ethylene dichloride research and the vinyl chloride research being administered by MCA.

In the case of ethylene dichloride, proposed additional studies were described in Mr. Clark's letter of June 24, 1977. Allied Chemical pledged its proportionate share for these studies, namely \$13,616. Allied paid the first invoice for \$8,170 in October 1977 and is still committed for the difference of \$5,446. We have not invoiced for the remaining 40% yet. Would ICI Americas desire to undertake Allied's participation and obligation on this research? If so, please fill in the enclosed commitment form for this amount, along with the designation of a management contact and a technical panel representative.

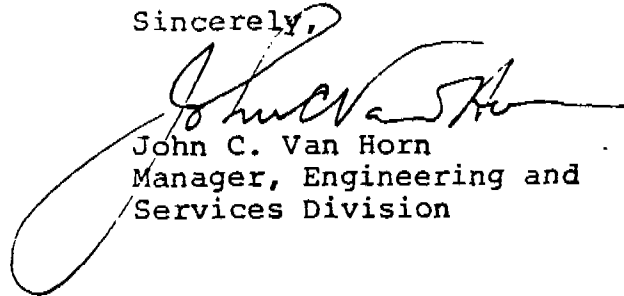
In the case of vinyl chloride, as you can see from the copy of Mr. Clark's letter of December 13, 1978, we have recently advised participating companies of the costs of completing the third year of a three-year research program at the University of Louisville. In view of the sale of its plant, Allied has declined the opportunity to participate. Would ICI Americas desire to support this research effort? Your proportionate share would be \$9,247. If so, please return one copy of the pledge form, again designating a management contact and a technical panel representative.
