Storm Deaths Stand at 24

Tornadoes battered four mid-western states late Saturday leaving 24 persons dead or missing and more than 100 injured.

Northeast Oklahoma, victim of a twister the second time in less than a week, was the hardest hit. Twenty were dead or missing in this area and upwards of 100 injured. The storm area was about 100 miles long and fifty miles wide in the vicinity of Pawhuska.

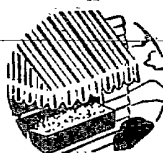
Earlier in the week one of the worst storms the state has known devastated the boom town of Pryor, killing 61 persons and leaving millions of dollars in property damage.

Three were killed in eastern Kansas Saturday, bringing that state's toll for the week to 18. Scores were injured.
